COURSE OF STUDY

EXPLANATORY WORD

Upon entering High School each student will choose one of the four courses offered, and after this, will not be permitted to make a change without the sanction of the student's parents and the principal of the High School.

Course I has been so organized as to provide the training requisite to entering the best colleges and universities.

Courses II, III and IV provide a good academic education and may also prepare for college work. It is intended that these courses shall help prepare the students for their life work.

One hundred and sixty hours of credits represent the sixteen units of credit required for the graduation. Five forty-five minute recitations per week, for one year, requiring preparation in advance, count as one credit. Subjects not requiring advance preparation, represent one-half credit in the same length of time.

Four regular subjects, one semester, make twenty hours of work. Students may elect additional work to the amount of three hours; but not more, except by the consent of the teachers.

No credit toward graduation in the preparatory course will be given for less than two years of foreign language; four

years of English; two years of mathematics; two years of history (one of which to be American history), and one year of science. Requirements for Courses II, III and IV are the same except that no foreign language is required.

At least one year each of history and mathematics are required within the first three years of work. Not less than two years of agriculture may be taken by any student for credit, even if not taking Course IV.

Students will be classified according to the hours of work, as follows:

First year students from.....	0 to 34 hours
Second year students from.....	34 to 74 hours
Third year students from.....	74 to 144 hours
Fourth year students from.....	144 to 160 hours and over.

COURSE I—AGRICULTURE.

First Year

REQUIRED—Agriculture, I; English, I; Business Arithmetic; Applied General Science.

ELECTIVE—Algebra, I; Spanish, I; Ancient History; Applied Drawing (Drafting); Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science.

Second Year

REQUIRED—Agriculture, II; English, II; Industrial History; Horticulture and Industrial Biology.

ELECTIVE—Geometry, I; Spanish, II; Applied Drawing (Drafting); Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science; Mediaeval History.

Third Year

REQUIRED—Agriculture, III; English, III; Applied Book-keeping; Soil Analysis and Practical Chemistry.

ELECTIVE—Spanish, III; Applied Drawing (Drafting); Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science; Mediaeval History.

Fourth Year

REQUIRED—Agriculture, IV; American History; Farm Mechanics; Farm Construction Work (if not taken before).

ELECTIVE—Typewriting; Applied Drawing (Drafting); Chorus Singing; Algebra, Geometry, Business English.

COURSE II--PREPARATORY

First Year

REQUIRED English; Algebra; Spanish or Latin, I.

ELECTIVE Farm Construction Work; Applied General Science; Agriculture; Ancient History; Business Arithmetic; Chorus Singing, and Domestic Science.

Second Year

REQUIRED--English; Geometry, I; Spanish or Latin, II.

ELECTIVE--Mediaeval History; Bookkeeping; Industrial Biology and Horticulture; Agriculture; Chorus Singing; Applied Drawing; Farm Construction Work, and Domestic Science.

Third Year

REQUIRED--English; Advanced Algebra; Ancient History (if not taken before).

ELECTIVE--Mediaeval History; Civics; Applied Drawing; Typewriting; Farm Construction Work; Agriculture; Bookkeeping; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science; Practical Chemistry, I; Spanish, III.

Fourth Year

REQUIRED Farm Mechanics; English; American History.

ELECTIVE English; Commercial Law; Applied Drawing; Bookkeeping; Typewriting; Spanish or Latin; Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science, and Agriculture.

COURSE III--COMMERCIAL COURSE

First Year

REQUIRED English; Business Arithmetic; Applied General Science ($\frac{1}{2}$); Practical Chemistry ($\frac{1}{2}$).

ELECTIVE--Algebra; Spanish; Ancient History; Applied Drawing; Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science, and Agriculture.

Second Year

REQUIRED--English; Mediaeval History; Bookkeeping.

ELECTIVE Geometry, I; Horticulture and Industrial Biology; Spanish; Applied Drawing; Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science, and Agriculture.

Third Year

REQUIRED—English; Algebra (if not taken before); Advanced Bookkeeping.

ELECTIVE—Spanish (if not taken before); Practical Chemistry; Applied Drawing; Agriculture; Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science; Typewriting; Commercial Law; Stenography, I.

Fourth Year

REQUIRED—American History; Commercial English; Farm Mechanics.

ELECTIVE—Spanish (if not taken before); Typewriting; Agriculture; Applied Drawing; Farm Construction Work; Chorus Singing; Domestic Science and Economics; Stenography, II.

COURSE IV—HOUSEHOLD ARTS

First Year

REQUIRED—English; Algebra; Cookery and Sewing.

ELECTIVE—Algebra; Spanish or Latin; American History; Applied General Science; Business Arithmetic; Chorus Singing; Agriculture.

Second Year

REQUIRED—English; Mediaeval History; Cookery and Dressmaking.

ELECTIVE—Geometry, I; Spanish or Latin; Bookkeeping; Horticulture and Industrial Biology; Applied Drawing; Chorus Singing; Agriculture.

Third Year

REQUIRED—English; Practical Chemistry; Business Arithmetic.

ELECTIVE—Spanish or Latin (if not taken before); Applied Drawing; Chorus Singing; Agriculture; Typewriting; Advanced Algebra; Civics.

Fourth Year

REQUIRED—American History; Laundry; Dressmaking and Millinery; Farm Mechanics.

ELECTIVE—Commercial Geography; Spanish or Latin; Commercial Law; Typewriting; Applied Drawing; Chorus Singing; Economics; Agriculture.
