Much good has been, and is being, accomplished by the Maricopa County Poultry Association as an organization for the promotion of more and better poultry for the Salt River Valley.

The time has come when every hen must do her bit. In the face of the present high cost of grain and other poultry foods it no longer pays layers not producing at least ten dozen eggs each, per year.

The Salt River Valley is recognized as one of the best, if not the best place for poultry production in the entire United States as our stock can be out of doors during the entire year with little or no wet weather, strong winds or cold, which is so detrimental to the welfare of all fowls. There, too, is always an abundance of green feed, which is so necessary to the production of winter eggs and to insure a high degree of fertility in the breeding yards. The cost of buildings to accommodate a good-sized flock is virtually nothing as compared to what our Northern and Eastern breeders are obliged to pay for housing.

It is nothing unusual for a flock of pullets to produce from 50 to 60 per cent egg yield for the months of November, December and January, and this is the time when eggs are always selling at a premium. The officers and members of the Association are always glad to assist a stranger or novice in getting well started, and it is our constant desire to be of assistance at all times to the experienced poultryman as well.
